SUPERFUND SITES

- 4 Woodtreating sites
- All fund lead sites
- Estimated Match Costs \$9MM - \$13MM
- How to fund?

ARCHITECTURAL DEBRIS

- New guidance document on disposal
- Solid wastes from construction, demolition, and renovation
- Covers asbestos, lead-based paint, fluorescent light bulb, PCB small capacitors and fluorescent light ballast, and treated lumber (CCA, PCP, creosote)

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

- Large quantities still being generated, especially in three coastal counties
- Electronics has become significant portion of household wastes for disposal
- One permanent household hazardous waste collection site in the three counties
 - Operates on a call and schedule appointment
 - Collection site overwhelmed

OTHER

- Debris removal from bayous, bays, waterways
- Closure of construction and debris landfills
