- ▶ August 2022 year-to-date profit and loss statement reflects ~ **\$280,000** positive net revenue
- ▶ ACE net revenue (to date) ~ **\$130,000**
- ▶ Overall - finances are better than budget
 - ▶ Partly due to ~ **\$160,000** PPP, etc. (COVID)
 - ▶ Mostly due to Stephanie and her team
